Planted within Sandy's Block (growing in well-drained, sandy soil) Clone 828 shines with lifted and perfumed characteristics, however, is even more intense in delicacy and aromatics. This clone was selected as an individual bottling due to its round and complete qualities, offering excellent characteristics of structure, color, and complexity. Consisting of tight clusters and small berries, Clone 828 ripens earlier than the others in the block, is hand-harvested at night, and fermented 1/3 whole cluster in the same method as Sandy's Block. Clone 828 is a Sandy's standout - we are thrilled with the quality of the fruit and the incredible wine it produces. We are proud to offer this wine as a Monopole exclusive for Spring 2022.
